

CODE OF CONDUCT

JYC 2021

The purpose of Jodhamal Youth Conclave is to implement the best practices of collaboration, cooperation and constructive debate irrespective of an individual's race, gender, political or sexual orientation, age, or nationality. To that end, all JYC participants agree to adhere to the following Code of Conduct.

1. Courteous behaviour towards JYC Executive Board Members and others assisting in the Committee.
2. No use of graphics (photos, clip art, drawings) at any time unless approved in advance by the Executive Board Members.
3. No use of music or other audio recordings during debate or lobbying sessions.
4. Constructive and positive chat in Zoom Connect and all JYC social media outlets.
5. Respectful spoken and written language at all times (no derogatory or personal attacks on individual or country positions).
6. Failure to abide by the Code of Conduct will result in a warning and possible suspension from JYC.

- **The delegates requested to have a proper Internet Connection.**
- **The Delegates should be in proper dress code while attending the conference and should be seated at a particular place while the conference is going on.**
